Entry

This programme is specially designed for students who have successfully completed AD / HD in language disciplines in a local university such as:

- Associate of Arts in Applied Chinese Studies
- Associate of Arts in Applied Japanese Studies
- Associate of Arts in Bilingual Communication Studies
- Associate of Arts in English for Professional Communications
- Associate of Arts in Translation and Interpretation

Graduates of other Associate Degree / Higher Diploma programmes may also be considered.

English Language Requirements

Students are expected to have achieved one of the following within 12 months of application:

- IELTS (Academic) 6.0 with Reading and Writing sub scores of 6.0
- Associate Degree students may meet English language requirements with specified minimum GPAs in English courses (normally a B- grade)
- Other students will be considered on a case by case basis

Special Features

Students will be equipped with critical thinking and analytical skills, cultural sensitivity and competency in international relations and foreign language proficiency.
